A primary goal of Montessori philosophy is “Help me to do it my self”. We want to encourage children to learn by doing and to incorporate, a sense of learning and accomplishment into their every day tasks and activities. Our toddler class room provides the opportunity for the toddlers, to acquire the skills to do it my self. Toddlers in our class room are doing a wonderful job by participating and finishing their class room activities .

This week we practiced Montessori ground rules, transferring from one container to another, differences of sizes (big and small). We are also learning primary colors (red ,blue and yellow). Children are learning how to use safety scissors for cutting papers. Children practiced how to roll and unroll rugs. Over all the toddlers are a fun, active bunch of children.

Please remember to dress your child in appropriate attire for bathroom success. While your child is in training (toileting), please select clothing that allows your child to be independent in the bathroom. Underwear that is comfortable enough for your child to pull up and down, as well as pants without buttons, snaps and zippers. Sweat pants with elastic waist are easy to take down and pull up.
