On Wednesday we took our butterflies outside and released them. One of the students asked “why can’t we just let them stay in our classroom and fly around?” I explained that the butterflies would not survive indoors, but that we are going to plant flowers in our garden that will attract butterflies. So hopefully our butterflies will come back.

In our **Science area** we have started to talk about what plants need to grow. We began our investigation of plant life by exploring the similarities and differences amongst a variety of seeds. We observed that seeds come in different sizes and shapes, and started noticing the seeds in foods we eat cucumbers, bananas, and oranges.

In our **Sensorial area** the students have started working together to combine the pink tower and brown stairs with the knob less cylinders.

In our **Writing area** some students are working on writing their own last name and their classmates names. While others are working on letter formation and writing/ tracing their name.

In our **Math area** we are working on missing numbers or what number comes next.
